Private Member's Agreement

PRIVATE PET PARADISE is a Private Member's Association (PMA) Pure Trust for members only. Anyone can join as a member upon agreement. Membership is one \$1.00 for life, plus any additional costs for additional boarding services.

This is a private member's Pet Boarding / Sitting Contract (hereinafter "this Agreement") between pet owner (granter), pet sitters (trustees) and pet guests (beneficiaries). *Members agree as follows;*

1. Do we have permission to go to a veterinarian of our choice, if we are unable to access yours in an emergency or they are closed? Charges would be the responsibility of the pet owner. Yes Check Box No Check Box
2. Pet sitters agree to exercise due diligence and reasonable care to do their best to protect pets and provide for their mental and physical well-being, which includes diligent supervision, keeping premises clean, sanitary and properly enclosed and doing their best to make the pet happy.
3. Pet owner understands and accepts all natural risks that are unforeseen (outside of pet sitters control) in a natural environment, which may result in injury to pet. This includes, but is not limited to all natural accidents where pet sitter's enclosure may be ineffective (*under normal conditions in a natural environment*).
4. Pet owner agrees to pay the rate (\$30 for cats, \$40 for dogs) for boarding due at pick-up. Pets will not be released before payment completion. Owner further agrees to pay all costs and charges associated with any emergency

veterinarian services and for veterinary transportation costs (*gas only calculated at 65.5 cents per mile driven*) if needed. There are no other hidden fees of any kind and high quality food is complimentary or you can supply your own.

5. LIMITED LIABILITY WAIVER; Pet owner understands that in no event shall the responsibility and/or liability of the pet sitters exceeds the sum of the costs of the initial services and pet owner agrees to limit the responsibility and all damages sustained or suffered to the cost of the services paid.
6. Pet owner specifically represents that its pet/animal(s) have not previously shown signs of aggression towards other animals or people and further agrees to be fully responsible and liable for all acts or behavior of said pet animal/s while in the care of pet sitters.
7. Guests are charged every Twenty-Four (24) hours from their initial arrival time, (eg. arrive at 3pm, one day = 24 hours after your drop-off time).
8. Upon approval of the staff, reservations will only be confirmed upon receipt of a completed and signed member's boarding agreement and any required veterinary records.
9. Pet owner does hereby entrust pet sitters to care for said pet(s) and authorizes pet sitters, at their sole discretion, to perform whatever is necessary for the health and well-being of the Owner's pet/animal(s).
10. Pet owner acknowledges that despite pet sitter's best effort to avoid accidents and illness, that such accidents and illnesses sometimes occur. In the event of a life-threatening situation, and pet sitters cannot communicate with pet owner directs that pet sitters shall (choose just **one** of the following):

Initial: Engage in all possible measures to save the pet/animal(s)

Initial: Defer to the veterinarian's recommendation

11. If pet owner fails to return to pick up their pets due to death or other, what is the pet owner's wishes for the care of their pet? Do you have an heir?

14. If pet sitters determine the presence of mange or fleas or the like, sitters will ask owner for permission to treat pet, free of charge with non-toxic treatments you first approve of, such as Diatomaceous Earth for fleas. Bathing is also at our discretion (with non-toxic shampoos) and also free of charge.

15. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this contract shall be settled by a court of equity first or secondly through a private arbitration service in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.
16. This Agreement contains the entire private **Member's Agreement** between, parties, and all terms and conditions will be in effect for this and all future boarding at pet sitters. Any changes to this contract must be agreed to in writing by both parties. All terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be binding upon all parties and on the heirs, administrators, and assignees of the pet owner, of the within named pet(s) / animal(s).
